The purpose of today's meeting is to present intermediate design, answer questions and receive your input.

### Background


The 61st and Radial Storm Sewer (CSO) Project includes construction of both sanitary and storm sewer to provide sewer separation to 101 acres in the area. The purpose of this project is to improve water quality in Cole Creek by reducing the amount of combined sewer overflows released into Cole Creek during rain events.

In this area, rainwater and wastewater currently flow through the same pipes. During heavy rain, this can cause polluted water to overflow into Cole Creek. By separating stormwater from sewage, this project prevents polluted overflows during rain and helps keep Cole Creek cleaner and healthier.

The project area is located in the Cole Creek Basin, and is bounded on the north by Spaulding St, on the east by N 60th St, on the south by Maple St, and on the west by N 63rd St.

### Phases

The project is planned to have four phases as well as potential other work that could occur at any phase.

### Project Schedule:


60% project design is in progress. We anticipate final design to be complete in 2026 and construction to begin in 2027.
